27/6/24	Rhyl flats & gwynt y mor funds information. Hi Brenda Thank you for attending the funding surgery this afternoon to discuss your project proposal at the park. Please find below, information from a Gwynt y Mor and Rhyl Flats perspective: <i>As with the Community Lottery Fund, we will ideally need to see some form of lease agreement for the park between yourselves and the Council.</i>

- For leases we will need to see a minimum of a 5-year lease on project completion on applications under £50K or 10-year lease on project completion for applications over 50K
- Grants panels are held 4 times each year, with the next panel in September, December, March and so on. Applications will need to be submitted by the 1st of the month before panel, so 1st August for September, 1st November for December etc.
- Gwynt y mor small grants are £1001 - £25,000 (these are discussed quarterly)
- Gwynt y Mor large grants are £25,001 - £75,000 (these are discussed each June, with deadline for applications being 1st March)
- Rhyl Flats grants start at £2,000 and go to £10,000 and you can apply to Gwynt y Mor and Rhyl Flats using one application form.
- Playground equipment – needs to comply with BS EN 1176 for equipment and surfacing.
